**1 - REGISTER 1<sup>ST</sup>!** Please sign in and get a bid number – you will use this number for any bids, beer, wine and cake purchases. Contact information is collected only in case post-auction follow-up is needed.

**2 - BUY YOUR TICKETS:** Tickets are needed to bid on parties (see below) or to buy beer, wine, and cake. Party tickets are \$.25 per person and can be purchased in any amount. For example, \$5 buys you 20 tickets. Consider how many chances you want to take on parties, how many beverages you want and how much cake you'll eat! Beer and wine are \$2 per serving and a slice of cake is \$3. If you do not plan to drink alcohol, buy cake or bid on a party event, bypass ticket sales. **TICKET SALES ARE OPEN UNTIL 6:30 PM.**

**3 - ENJOY THE AUCTION PARTY AND BID!**

**FOOD:** Please enjoy our complimentary appetizers.

**DRINKS:** All non-alcoholic beverages are FREE. Beer and wine must be purchased, either by buying a ticket or paying \$2 cash at the bar (exact change, please). **By law, we cannot give out free alcohol.**

**SILENT AUCTION:** *Open from 5pm-6:30pm. Services, Gift Cards, Artisan, and Never Been Opened* - Write your number and your bid on the bid sheet, and remember to check frequently, because it can change quickly! No tickets necessary.

**ARTISAN MARKET:** One-of-a-kind, limited edition and handcrafted items. Some items have a fixed price because there are multiple units of the same item – be the first to sign up! There will also be items that follow the same guidelines as the Silent Auction – bid and keep checking. No tickets necessary.

**PARTIES:** We are using a lottery system to get a chance to win a spot for the party of your choice. Tickets required. More tickets=more chances to win!

**You are still responsible for paying for the party price,** regardless of how many tickets you purchased.

**Please write your bid number** on the tickets. You can use our volunteer ticket writers for this purpose. Look for the people behind the ticket table to help you.

**Tickets are color coordinated.** If you want to attend a party as a single guest, your \$.25 tickets will be red. If you want to attend as a couple, your \$.50 ticket will be white. If you want to attend as a family, just let the ticket seller know how many people the ticket is for and write that number on one side of the yellow ticket. (Family tickets are sold at \$.25 per person.)

**Group 1 Party winners** will be selected at 5:40.

**Group 2 party winners** will be selected at 6:10.

**ENTERTAINMENT:** When the silent auction ends at 6:30, please go to the sanctuary for a short musical performance. Everyone must leave the Parish Hall at this time so that the room can be transformed for the live auction.

**CAKE:** Our fancy cakes will be on display during the silent auction. **There is no need to reserve your slice.** After the entertainment, please take a seat at one of the tables in the Parish Hall and put your cake ticket on the table in front of you. Cake servers will come to you. You can choose your slice then and the cake servers will collect your ticket. One ticket per slice of cake (\$3). You are very welcome to buy more than one slice and will need the corresponding ticket for it. **YOU MUST PURCHASE A CAKE TICKET PRIOR TO THE CLOSE OF TICKET SALES IN ORDER TO RECEIVE CAKE!** Plastic wrap will be available in case you want to take a slice home with you.

**LIVE AUCTION:** Starts at 7:15 (after the entertainment portion of the night). Stay to bid and have fun.

**CHECK OUT:** Check out starts shortly after the entertainment concludes. When you are ready, please proceed to the checkout lane. You will receive a folder that will have your bill for tickets (lottery for parties, drinks, and/or cake) and any other items you won. It will include party reminders if you qualify, gift certificates and other information that you may need regarding services that you have bought. Your teller will calculate your total amount, you will pay and then pick up your artisan, live auction and never-been-opened items. **SORRY, BUT THERE WILL BE NO CHECK OUT BEFORE 7:15 PM. Thank you for your patience.**
